Holy Gospel

Luke 17 : 11 – 19

On the way to Jerusalem Jesus[Ⓜ] was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. ¹²As he entered a village, ten lepers[Ⓜ] approached him. Keeping their distance, ¹³they called out, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" ¹⁴When he saw them, he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were made clean. ¹⁵Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. ¹⁶He prostrated himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan. ¹⁷Then Jesus asked, "Were not ten made clean?
