Reflection on the Feast of the Conception of Saint Anna

Today we celebrate God's merciful intervention in the lives of Joachim and Anna, who conceived the Mother of God after years of prayer and longing. Their story reminds us that

nothing is impossible for God and that His grace often arrives when all human hope seems gone.

The conception of Mary marks the beginning of our salvation—God preparing a pure vessel for the coming of Christ. This feast invites us to trust more deeply in God's timing and to believe that He can bring new life, healing, and hope even in the most unlikely situations.

May Saints Joachim and Anna strengthen us in faith, and may the Theotokos lead us closer to her Son.
